

Which Level Should I Start at?

It will depend on the qualifications and / or work experience you have already gained.

If you have good numeracy skills and existing business / administrative knowledge you will be able to join the course directly at the Foundation Certificate Level.

If you also have work experience or qualifications within manual bookkeeping and basic costing there may an option to start at the Advanced Diploma in Accounting Level.

To assess which level you can start at, you will be required to either provide current (qualification that are completed within the last three years) and relevant qualifications. You can email them to info@premiertraining.co.uk and our assessors will advise if you are eligible for any exemptions.

If you have bookkeeping/accounting work experience you will be required to complete a short online initial assessment that on completion is marked by an assessor. We will then contact you with the results and help you to make an informed decision.

AAT Access Award in Bookkeeping

AAT Access Award in Bookkeeping is a flexible home study qualification launched in January 2018 which can be studied via distance learning or by self - studying.

Access qualifications are an entry point for students who need to develop their finance or business skills. These qualifications are designed to give students the introductory knowledge and confidence to take on a higher level AAT qualification and to progress in their lives and careers.

Students should choose to study the AAT Access Award in Bookkeeping if they wish to develop an understanding of the basics of manual bookkeeping. Students completing this qualification may wish to pursue careers in finance or business in either the private or public sectors. This qualification compliments the other qualifications in the suite of AAT Access qualifications and may be combined with the AAT Access Award in Accounting Software to give a strong foundation for further study with AAT in either accountancy or bookkeeping.

No prior knowledge is required and the course can be completed in as little as 6 weeks depending on your study time.

The qualification covers a range of skills and the relevant supporting knowledge in one mandatory unit:

Access Award in Bookkeeping

Whilst completing this qualification you will develop an understanding of the role of the bookkeeper, including the need for confidentiality and accuracy in your work.

You will learn underpinning theory including how to identify assets, liabilities, income and expenses; how to identify profit and loss; and the differences between trading for cash and trading on credit.

You will also develop the skills to process customer and supplier transactions, to enter receipts and payments into the cash book and check amounts against the bank statement in preparation for bank reconciliation.

You will be introduced to the dual effect of transactions. This is a fundamental underpinning concept for double-entry bookkeeping and will support students who go on to study bookkeeping at Foundation level.

The skills developed in this qualification can lead to employment in junior or supporting administrative roles in companies across a wide range of sectors, for example, as a:

- trainee bookkeeper
- accounts administrator
- billing/payments administrator/coordinator
- accounts junior
- accounts receivable/payable assistant
- procurement and finance assistant
- · assistant cashier





AAT Foundation Certificate in Bookkeeping

The AAT Foundation Certificate in Bookkeeping is a short qualification to help students develop essential bookkeeping skills. Once completed, they will have developed an understanding of basic accounting practices and techniques including double-entry bookkeeping.

Depending on your abilities, previous work experience and qualifications and your work and family commitments it can take 2 to 3 months to complete this course. After completion of this course if you have evidence of prior learning or work experience which proves certain skills and knowledge in computerised accounting and basic costing, students may even be able to progress straight to the AAT Level 3 Diploma in Accounting QCF.

AAT Foundation Award in Accounting Software

The Foundation Award in Computerised Accounting is a short qualification with one unit. Developed as a stand-alone nationally recognised qualification, the Award in Accounting Software is perfect for those who need to get to grips with computerised accounting software and enhance their current knowledge, allowing them to use such software in the work environment. This single unit qualification is available at Foundation on the QCF.

The software you will be working on is Sage Business Cloud Accounting. With cloud-based software becoming even more popular in the world of business this course is ideal to gain the necessary skills needed to enter data accurately and efficiently.

Many employers are switching to cloud software so this course will make you an asset to current and future employers.

The course materials have been produced to take you through the software step by step. You will have practice assessments to work through so when you enter for the exam you will have the confidence to succeed.



AAT Advanced Certificate in Bookkeeping

The purpose of the AAT Advanced Certificate in Bookkeeping is to ensure that students have the advanced bookkeeping skills necessary to work in a bookkeeping role or to progress to higher level accountancy. Students will gain the knowledge and skills needed to carry out advanced bookkeeping transactions and tasks in three mandatory units (210 guided learning hours).

The qualification is composed of three mandatory units assessed in three end-of-unit assessments:

- Advanced Bookkeeping
- Final Accounts Preparation
- Indirect Tax

The skills developed in the AAT Advanced Certificate in Bookkeeping can lead to employment as:

- a professional bookkeeper
- a senior bookkeeper an accounts manager
- a ledger manager

Once you have completed the AAT Advanced Certificate in Bookkeeping, you can apply for AAT Licensed Bookkeeper status

AAT Foundation Certificate in Accounting (Level 2)

A student completing this qualification will develop skills in double-entry bookkeeping and will understand how to use journals, control accounts and a trial balance.

Students will also learn how to use an accounting software package, how to process financial information in accordance with company procedures and schedules, and how to provide information to colleagues, suppliers and / or customers as required.

The finance, accountancy, business and communications skills developed in the AAT Foundation Certificate in Accounting can lead to employment as:

- an accounts administrator
- · an accounts assistant
- an accounts payable clerk

AAT Advanced Diploma in Accounting (Level 3)

The AAT Advanced Diploma in Accounting covers a range of complex accounting tasks, including maintaining cost accounting records and the preparation of reports and returns. Students will learn and master financial processes, including accounting principles and concepts, advanced bookkeeping, final accounts, VAT issues in business, management accounting costing techniques and ethical practices for accountants. This qualification further delivers software skills through spreadsheet training for accounting.

The accountancy skills attained though the successful completion of this qualification will enable a student to seek employment with confidence. Skills developed through this qualification lead to employment such as:

- · an accounts assistant
- an accounts payable and expenses supervisor
- an accounts payable clerk
- · an assistant accountant
- an audit trainee
- · a credit controller
- a finance assistant

- a finance officer
- an indirect tax manager
- an insolvency executive

AAT Professional Diploma in Accounting (Level 4)

The purpose of the AAT Professional Diploma in Accounting is to enhance the skills developed from the AAT Advanced Diploma in Accounting qualification, enabling students to maximise opportunities in their current or new employment. By studying for this qualification students will acquire lifelong professional accountancy and finance skills, including:

- · drafting financial statements for limited companies
- gaining knowledge and skills in complex management accounting techniques
- ability to analyse accounting systems and their associated controls
- gaining knowledge and skills in specialist accountancy and finance subjects.

Students will look at and become comfortable with a wide range of financial management skills and applications, and gain competencies in: drafting financial statements for limited companies, recommending accounting systems strategy, construction and presentation of complex management accounting reports. Students will also learn about specialist areas such as tax, auditing, credit management and cash and treasury management.

This qualification comprises four mandatory, and two optional units, from a choice of five options.

The mandatory units are as follows:

Assessments

Unit and synoptic assessments are not awarded grades individually, but the marks achieved in all assessments contribute to the student's overall grade for the qualification.

Students must successfully complete five unit assessments and one synoptic assessment to achieve this qualification. The proportion of this qualification assessed by external assessment is 100%.


Once qualified, students automatically become AAT affiliate members and with relevant work experience, will qualify for AAT full membership, enabling use of the designatory letters MAAT after their name.

AAT Awarding Body / Assessment Fees

In addition to the Premier Training course fees you will be required to pay a student registration fee to the AAT and assessment fees to the AAT Approved Assessment Centre (AAC).

You are required to register with the AAT within four weeks of enrolling with a training provider.

Remember you can include your AAT registration fees of £150 in your monthly instalments.

Assessment fees are payable to the assessment centre as and when you book each assessment. The fees will vary depending on the centre and consist of the AAT Assessment fee and Assessment Centre Administration fee. A fee is payable for every individual unit assessment and synoptic assessment.

As the fees vary so much we can only give you an approximate idea of what they will be.
